This year we are giving a total of \$234,300 to 35 different agencies, plus an additional 5 grants totaling \$25,000 to match the UW Philanthropy Lab Class decisions, and we hope this will motivate hope and support to others. We certainly wish we could fill all the requests, but it must be a community effort. We also encourage our 100+ employees to donate to non-profit agencies by matching any of their personal gifts up to \$2,500 to the program or project of their choice, which totals another major company investment!
